



Five Card Hold Out is a Community Card Poker Game.

**The betting structure consists of four betting rounds;
The Pre-Flop, The Flop, The Turn and The River.**

1. Five cards are dealt face down to each player. Players may discard up to four of the original five cards dealt. Discarded cards are placed face down in front of each player. The dealer removes the discarded cards from the table.

ALL HELD CARDS MUST PLAY

2. The community cards (flop, turn and river) replace each player's discarded cards. Example: Players who discard 1 card may claim one community card. Discard 2 Claim 2, Discard 3 Claim 3, Discard 4 Claim 4

3. The dealer then burns a card and exposes two community cards (the flop) in the center of the table. The player closest to the left of the dealer button, may check, bet, raise, or fold. Once all the action is completed, the dealer burns a card and exposes a turn card. A betting round begins with the player closest to the left of the dealer button. Once all the action is completed, the dealer burns a card and exposes a river card and a final round of betting begins.

4. Once all action is complete, if there are two or more players still in the hand, the dealer will call for a show-down. Poker hands must be exactly five cards and only those five cards are used to evaluate the winning hand.

Strategy: Players should pay close attention to how many cards the other players are discarding.
